

*Scholarship Criteria for the Harper County Conservation District
Conservation Leadership Scholarship*

- Purpose:** The Harper County Conservation District awards two scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in pursuing a career that will enhance better conservation of our state's natural resources.
- Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in Harper County, Kansas, attend a Harper County High School and intend to continue their education in an accredited college or university. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and student's community service record. Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided, and an essay of at least 500 words that explain how their chosen career path will benefit conservation of our natural resources in Kansas.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in one payment payable to the school of choice, in August, with proof of enrollment in an accredited college or university.
- Amount:** Each scholarship awarded will be \$500.00.
- Deadline:** The application and essay deadline is April 1, 2024. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. The Harper County Conservation District uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
- Renewal:** This scholarship is not renewable. Only high school seniors intending to enroll in an accredited college or university are eligible to apply.
